How It Works

Here's how it works: your deposit is converted into Wrapped Bitcoin (WBTC), a trusted token that mirrors Bitcoin's price 1:1 on Ethereum's blockchain. The tokens are held in a secure Ethereum smart contract—funds remain fully under your name and cannot be lent or reused.

The entire process is **completely transparent and traceable**. Otherwise, it functions just like a traditional rental deposit.
